

## Scout Program Descriptions

### **Arrow of Light Into the Wild**

Grades 4-5, 2 hours, \$9 per Scout

Based on the Cub Scout Adventure

Scouts will learn about animal habitats and food webs, then explore animal habitats at Asbury Woods.

### **Arrow of Light Into the Woods**

Grades 4-5, 1.5 hours, \$9 per Scout

Based on the Cub Scout Adventure

Scouts will learn about trees and how they work, then go on a hike to practice identifying trees along our trails.

### **Bear Champions for Nature**

Grade 3, 2 hours, \$9 per Scout

Based on the Cub Scout Adventure

Scouts learn about water and soil, how they can become polluted, and how we can keep pollution out.

### **Bear Habitat**

Grade 3, 1.5 hours, \$9 per Scout

Based on the Cub Scout Adventure

Scouts will prepare for and go on a hike on Asbury Woods trails. Along the way, we will practice outdoor ethics and look for animal signs.

### **Brownie Bugs**

Grades 2-3, 1.5 hours, \$9 per Scout

Based on the Girl Scout Badge

Scouts will learn about a bug's life cycle and what bugs need to live. They will look for bugs outside and make a bug craft.

### **Brownie Hiker**

Grades 2-3, 1.5 hours, \$9 per Scout

Based on the Girl Scout Badge

Scouts will learn how to prepare for a hike and practice outdoor ethics. We will go on a hike to practice our new skills.

**Brownie Letterboxer**

Grades 2-3, 1.5 hours, \$9 per Scout

Based on the Girl Scout Badge

Scouts will learn about letterboxing, practice solving clues, and hunt for a letterbox.

**Brownie Outdoor Art Creator**

Grades 2-3, 2 hours, \$9 per Scout

Based on the Girl Scout Badge

Scouts will explore the colors of nature, hear nature's sounds, and design art projects with nature.

**Cross-Country Ski Clinic**

Grades 5-12, 1.5 hours, \$13 per Scout, Offered December – February

Scouts will learn how to put on and use cross country skis, then head out on a guided adventure on our ski trails. This program is unique to Asbury Woods and will help Scouts work toward badges and adventures related to snow activities or outdoor adventure.

**Daisy Outdoor Art Maker**

Grades K-1, 1 hour, \$9 per Scout

Based on the Girl Scout Badge

Scouts will discover the colors and sounds of nature, then make a nature art project of their own.

**Daisy Trail Adventure**

Grades K-1, 1 hour, \$9 per Scout

Based on the Girl Scout Badge

Scouts will learn how to prepare for a hike and hike safely. We will go on a short learning hike to practice our new skills.

**Junior Animal Habitats**

Grades 4-5, 2 hours, \$9 per Scout

Based on the Girl Scout Badge

Scouts will learn what animals need to survive, explore animal habitats, and make an animal home.

**Junior Geocacher**

Grades 4-5, 2 hours, \$9 per Scout

Based on the Girl Scout Badge

Scouts will learn about geocaching and how to use a GPS, then search for geocaches to practice their new skills.

**Junior Outdoor Art Explorer**

Grades 4-5, 2 hours, \$9 per Scout

Based on the Girl Scout Badge

Scouts will discover the beauty of nature, hear nature's sounds, and design art projects with nature.

**Lion Champions for Nature**

Kindergarten, 1 hour, \$9 per Scout

Based on the Cub Scout Adventure

Scouts will explore which materials are used to make various objects and learn the difference between natural and man-made items. They will learn about recycling and practice sorting materials into different recycling types.

**Low Ropes Course**

Grades 4-12, 2 or 4 hours, Offered April – October

Scouts will complete progressively harder teambuilding challenges to build the group's unity. We will start with field games, then move to our low ropes course. This program is unique to Asbury Woods and will help Scouts work toward badges and adventures related to outdoor adventure or working as a team.

**Maple Magic**

Grades 2-3, 2 hours, \$9 per Scout, Offered February – March

Scouts will learn about the structure of trees and how maple trees make sap. They will tour Asbury Woods' syrup-making process and sugar shack. This program is unique to Asbury Woods and will help Scouts work toward nature- or tree-themed badges and adventures.

**Mountain Lion**

Kindergarten, 1 hour, \$9 per Scout

Based on the Cub Scout Adventure

Scouts will learn how to prepare for a hike and hike safely. We will go on a short learning hike to practice our new skills.

**Orienteering Adventure**

Grades 4-5, 1.5 hours, \$9 per Scout

Scouts will learn how to use a compass, then practice what they learned before heading onto our compass course to use their new skills. The program is unique to Asbury Woods and will help Scouts work toward any badge or adventure that includes learning to use a compass.

**Snowshoe Clinic**

Grades K-4, 1.5 hours, \$13 per Scout, Offered December – February

Scouts will learn how to put on and walk in snowshoes, then go on a hike to practice. This program is unique to Asbury Woods and will help Scouts work toward badges and adventures related to snow activities or outdoor adventure.

**Tigers in the Wild**

Grade 1, 1 hour, \$9 per Scout

Based on the Cub Scout Adventure

Scouts will learn how to prepare for a hike and practice outdoor ethics. We will go on a short hike to practice our new skills.

**Tiger Sky Is the Limit**

Grade 1, 1.5 hours, \$9 per Scout, Offered November – March

Based on the Cub Scout Adventure

Scouts will discover what is in the daytime and nighttime sky and explore constellations and phases of the Moon. This is an evening program, so we can view the night sky.

**Webelos Earth Rocks**

Grades 4-5, 2 hours, \$9 per Scout

Scouts will learn about erosion and the rock cycle, exploring how water shapes the land and identifying specific rocks and rock types.
